



HB 458 VOTER SUPPRESSION BILL

HB458 represents voter suppression in Ohio. Republicans are desperate to make it harder for Ohioans to vote. We must inform every voter so they don't lose their right to vote. We must organize to fight against this law because our lives and our rights are on the line.

VOTER REGISTRATION

- Ohio Drivers License/State ID **accepted**
- Last four digits of Social Security number (SSN) **accepted**
- Military ID **not accepted**
- Ohio DL/ID with former address **not accepted**

VOTER IDENTIFICATION – IN PERSON EARLY VOTING AND ELECTION DAY

- Ohio Drivers License/State ID **accepted**
- US Passport/Passport Card **accepted**
- Military ID **accepted**
- Utility bill **not accepted** to vote
- Government documents and checks **not accepted** to vote
- **No** curbside voting except for disabled voter unable to physically enter the polling place
- Ohio DL/ID number or last four digits of SSN **not accepted** for in-person or provisional voting except for use of SSN for strict religious exemptions

EARLY VOTING RESTRICTIONS

- **No** voting on the Monday before Election Day (the second most popular day of early voting)
- Secretary of State will proscribe a new, **uniform** early voting schedule statewide

VOTING BY MAIL

- Ohio Drivers License/State ID number or last four digits of SSN **accepted for vote by mail only**
- Ohio Drivers License/State ID *with current or former address* **accepted for vote by mail only**
- Military ID **accepted**
- Mail in ballots must arrive at BOE within **4 days** after election day (was 10 days)
- Deadline to apply to cast Mail in ballots ends at close of business on the **7th day** before Election Day (was Noon on 3rd day before Election Day)
- BOE will begin counting late arriving and cured mail in ballots on the **5th day** after Election Day (was 11th day)
- Provisional voters have **4 days** after Election Day to return to their BOE for validation (was 7 days)
- Requires person who applies to cast mail in ballots to do so **only** on the Secretary of State proscribed form

OTHER INFORMATION

- State IDs **will be available free of charge** in Ohio from BMVs however they will require presentation of various documents including a birth certificate
