Why do you need to create an ActionID?

An ActionID account is required when using any NGPVAN products. This includes the MiniVAN app for canvassing, OpenVPB for phone banking, and Votebuilder.



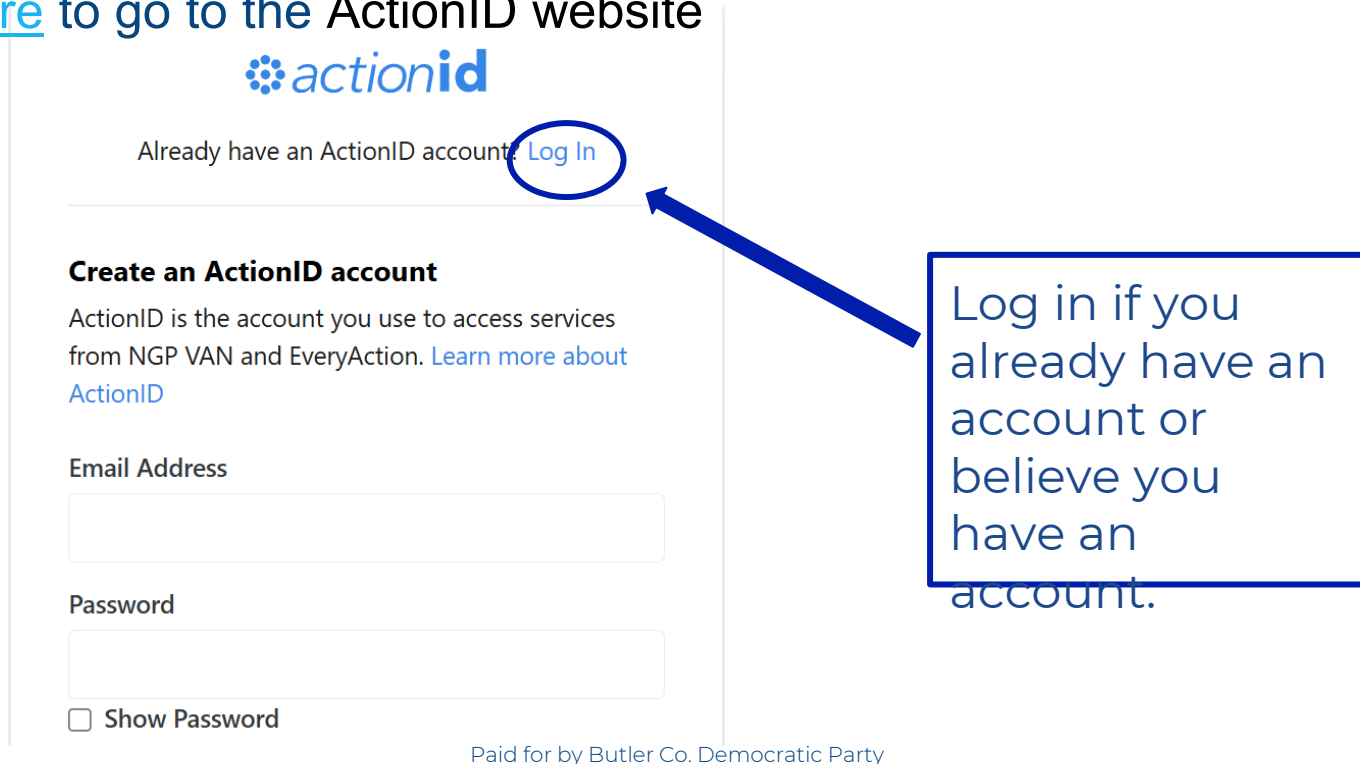
Start Making Calls

2-Factor Authentication

Use an authenticator app to set up 2-Factor Authentication. Google Authenticator is commonly used and safer than SMS and is preferred.
