



RELATIONAL ORGANIZING STEPS

EXAMPLES

- “Hey Aunt _____. Do you know who you’re voting for this year?”
 - “Sherrod Brown got my parents their full Social Security payments. Just like another 250,000 Ohioans.”
- “Hi _____, do me a favor and update your voter registration so you can vote this year. Republicans are cutting my sister’s SNAP benefits, and we have to stop them.”
- “Hey _____. Do you have a voting plan for this year? I know it’s hard to keep track of all the candidates but Vivek Ramaswamy moved his business out of Ohio and now wants to be governor. Please vote for Amy Acton.”
- “Republican tax cuts for billionaires means they’re cutting funding at my nonprofit agency. We all know how important housing is so we need to vote for Democrats.”
- “Did you know you can vote by mail?”
 - Defense of mail voting
 - The US military has been voting by mail for 250 years with no problems
 - Trump votes by mail. Why is it good enough for him and not us?
- Send them links
 - **Best link for Cuyahoga voters.** You can have them **check their registration, request a VBM ballot, find out when early voting starts, and look up their polling place** for Election Day: <https://boe.cuyahogacounty.gov/voters>

Today-October 5th

- Register or Update Your Registration

Today- October 16th

- Request a Vote-By-Mail Application

October 7th- November 2nd

- Encourage contacts to make a Voting Plan on when and where they’re going to vote

November 1st-3rd

- Encourage your contacts to vote on Election Day. Send link for them to look up polling place
- Polls are open 6:30 AM-7:30 PM
- Post images of you pre or post-voting and share them with contacts and on social media
